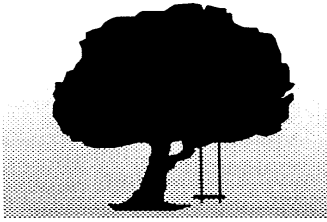


## BOSC – Frequently Asked Questions

**Pool News:** We are again looking forward to enjoying our pool and another great swim season at Black Oak Swim Club! We continue to work hard to keep our pool updated and well maintained. In 2016, we updated our tennis courts and they look amazing! We are also implementing our new membership software that should make membership renewal and daily check in at the pool so much easier. We continue to develop and prioritize future updates, such as the parking lot, to keep our club the best in the area. Please consider volunteering to help keep our pool beautiful by helping with Spring Clean-up activities.

**2017 Membership Cards:** We will use computerized check in. Cards issued last year will be reused. Replacement cards for the family will cost \$5.00. If you have not yet had the chance to have your profile picture taken, please stop by the front gate at your convenience this summer.

**Babysitter pass:** A babysitter pass is available for \$50.00. This pass is issued in the family's name and may be used by any **one** person ( $\geq 14$  yrs old) escorting your children to the pool. **A babysitter pass is not a valid membership card. It is only valid while accompanying a current member to the pool.**

**Guest Passes can be ordered when you renew your membership.** Ten guest passes can be purchased for \$40.00 (this is a \$10 discount off the gate price of \$5.00 per guest). With the membership software, the passes will be tracked electronically and can be viewed any time under your account.

**Grandchild Pass:** A Grandchild pass is available for \$50/grandchild. This option is available for our senior and family members who take care of their grandchildren.

**E-Mail Address:** Our number one form of communication is email. Be sure to update your email address when completing your registration online. Also, "like" us on Facebook and receive important information about BOSC.

### Swim and Dive Team:

2017 fees - \$80 for Swim OR Dive for first family member; \$70 for each additional swimmer OR diver  
\$110 for Swim AND Dive for first family member; \$100 for each additional swimmer AND diver

Please note: If you have a child swimming and diving in addition to child(ren) not participating on both teams, please pay the \$110 for the first child and then \$70 or \$100 per child for additional registrations. Please pay by April 1, 2017 to allow BOSC to plan for coaches, staff, and volunteer needs. The Swim and Dive Parent meeting will be held in May at the BOSC Clubhouse.

Your family members must be in the database to enter the pool.
